# Multicultural Education

- ☞ How do you define multicultural education?
- ☞ What does multicultural education include?
- ☞ Cite specific examples of multicultural education in your school, VBS, Sunday School, etc.

# Developing Relationships

- ☞ What strategies do you practice to develop relationships in your classroom?
- ☞ Do any of these have potential as unintended obstacles to students of other cultures?

# Safe & Caring Environment

- ☛ What evidence of safety is observable in your school or congregation?
- ☛ What do you do to create a sense of belonging?
- ☛ What difficulties frustrate your attempt to fully appreciate diverse cultures?

# Contributions Approach

- ☞ How do you recognize the contributions of other cultures?
- ☞ Identify specific sources of information, e.g., cultural calendars, famous people, etc.
- ☞ How might you include a contributions approach in religion lesson plans?

# Additive Approach

- ☛ What have you added or might you add to content, themes, and concepts that are already part of your curriculum?
- ☛ Identify specific resources that you need to implement this approach.



# Transformation Approach

- ☞ How does this approach differ from the previous two approaches?
- ☞ How can you stimulate students to view issues and ideas from more than one perspective?
- ☞ How often do you or should you use this approach?

# Social Action Approach

- ☛ At what age or grade level is this approach appropriate? (How might it be possible to take this approach even earlier?)
- ☛ How is this approach related to living life as a child of God, saved by Jesus Christ?

# Language

- ☛ Why is there a gap between “playground language” and “classroom language”?
- ☛ What strategies can you use as students work toward language proficiency?
